## Steps

- Temp **62 C**, Time **40 min**
- Temp **72 C**, Time **30 min**
- Temp **76 C**, Time **0 min**

## Mash step by step

- Heat up **16.2 liter(s)** of strike water to **69C**
- Add grains
- Keep mash **40 min** at **62C**
- Keep mash **30 min** at **72C**
- Keep mash **0 min** at **76C**
- Sparge using **14.9 liter(s)** of **76C** water or to achieve **25.7 liter(s)** of wort
