Steps

Mash step by step

- Heat up **9 liter(s)** of strike water to **73.7C**
- Add grains
- Keep mash **60 min** at **66C**
- Keep mash **5 min** at **76C**
- Sparge using **6.9 liter(s)** of **76C** water or to achieve **12.9 liter(s)** of wort
