Steps

- Temp **38 C**, Time **20 min**
- Temp **50 C**, Time **15 min**
- Temp **63 C**, Time **50 min**
- Temp **72 C**, Time **20 min**
- Temp **78 C**, Time **5 min**

Mash step by step

- Heat up **9.1 liter(s)** of strike water to **41C**
- Add grains
- Keep mash **20 min** at **38C**
- Keep mash **15 min** at **50C**
- Keep mash **50 min** at **63C**
- Keep mash **20 min** at **72C**
- Keep mash **5 min** at **78C**
- Sparge using **10.4 liter(s)** of **76C** water or to achieve **16.4 liter(s)** of wort
